PRESS RELEASE

On Friday, March 31, 2017, at 05:29am Berwyn Patrol Units responded to a call of two people down in the residence at 3129 S. Oak Park Avenue. Upon making entry into the residence, two victims, Ira Moore, 67 years old, a Vietnam Veteran and his wife Tommie Moore 70 years old, who had been married for over 20 years, were discovered deceased on the kitchen floor.

Throughout the investigation, information was developed that led to a suspect who was identified as Roger M. Scoby, a 40 year old male who is a resident of Schaumburg, Illinois. Scoby was taken into custody with the assistance of the United States Marshal's Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force.

Subsequently, additional evidence was located and recovered from Scoby's apartment in Schaumburg and from the interior of his vehicle. During the interview process, Roger Scoby confessed to committing the heinous criminal act of murder to Ira and Tommie Moore.

After reviewing all of the evidence, facts and interviews, the Cook County Assistant State's Attorney's Office approved charging Scoby with two counts of Murder. Scoby is being processed and prepared to attend a bond hearing on Saturday, April 8th, 2017.
